



OAFP Listserv Disclaimer and Usage Guidelines

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Each user is solely responsible for the content of any e-mails he/she posts to the listservs and agrees to indemnify and hold OAFP and its affiliates, officers, agents and employees harmless from any claim, demand or expense (including attorneys' fees) due to or arising out of the use of the listservs or of any information or materials provided via the listservs.

Usage Guidelines

1. Only information that can be expected to be of interest to members of the listserv by virtue of its relevance to either (1) clinical and socioeconomic issues in medicine or (2) OAFP-related activities should be posted.
2. Users may attach documents less than .5MB (500KB).
3. OAFP accepts no responsibility for the opinions and information posted by users.

4. Do not post any false, inaccurate, misleading, defamatory, tortuous, abusive, threatening, harassing, profane, obscene, offensive, pornographic, hateful, infringing, anti-competitive or illegal information or materials. OAFP does not condone and will not be responsible for any such information or materials or for any resulting liability.
5. OAFP does not actively monitor the lists for inappropriate postings and does not, on its own, undertake editorial control of postings. However, in the event that any inappropriate posting is brought to OAFP's attention, OAFP has the right but not the obligation to remove all or part of the posting and/or terminate the user's access to the lists. OAFP reserves the right to reveal users' identities (or whatever information it may know about the users) in the event of a complaint or legal action arising from any e-mails posted by users.
6. Do not post any information, software or other material protected by copyright, patent, trademark, trade secret or other proprietary right without the permission of the rights owner. By posting information, software or other material, the posting party warrants and represents that it owns such rights in the information, software or other material or has received permission from the person or entity who owns such rights in the information, software or other material. By posting information, software or other material, the posting party grants OAFP and other subscribers to the electronic mailing lists the non-exclusive right and license to display, copy, publish, distribute, transmit, print and use such information, software or other material. Subject to the grant of this license, the posting party retains any other rights that the party may have in such information, software or other material.
7. Do not post any information or materials that contain any virus, Trojan horse, corrupted file, worm, time bomb, cancelbot or other computer programming routine that is intended to damage, detrimentally interfere with, surreptitiously intercept or expropriate any system, data or information.
8. As the electronic mailing lists are not regularly monitored by OAFP, do not use them to communicate with OAFP staff members. E-mails can be sent to OAFP staff via mail@ohioafp.org.
9. OAFP reserves the right to terminate access to any user who does not abide by these guidelines. OAFP may modify, suspend or discontinue on a temporary or permanent basis the listservs at any time for any reason. All rights of termination shall be within the sole discretion of OAFP.
10. If a user wants to unsubscribe from an OAFP listserv or change his/her e-mail address, the user can send an e-mail with his/her name, e-mail address and listserv(s) name(s) to listserv@ohioafp.org. An OAFP staff member then will handle the request.
11. Advertising is prohibited on the listservs, except with prior approval by an OAFP senior staff member.
12. OAFP does not allow outside research surveys and/or studies for placement in any of its communications including *The Ohio Family Physician*, *The Weekly Family Medicine Update*, OAFP Web site, e-mail blast system, listservs or public relations efforts to preserve the mission of OAFP and the integrity of OAFP communications.
13. Pricing discussions are strictly prohibited on the listservs. "Pricing" refers to any mention of monetary figures related to what organizations or individuals charge or may charge for their services, products, time or expertise. This does not apply when discussing OAFP operations, fundraising or other such OAFP-sanctioned activities.
