

## Ohio Resident Delegate and Alternate Delegate to the National Congress of Family Medicine Residents

Apply today to represent your fellow Ohio family medicine residents at the [National Congress of Family Medicine Residents](#) (NCFMR) hosted in conjunction with the American Academy of Family Physicians (AAFP) **FUTURE** conference (formerly National Conference of Family Medicine Residents and Medical Students) **Thursday-Saturday, July 31 – August 2, 2025**.

The resident delegate and alternate delegate will represent Ohio's residents during discussions, resolution writing, and elections at the congress sessions. While any resident member of the AAFP may participate in congress discussions and resolution writing, only chapter delegates are eligible to vote in elections. The alternate resident delegate serves in a partner role to the delegate and as a backup in case the delegate is not able to vote.

Delegates and alternate delegates will:

- Represent OAFP's resident members at their national policy making forum
- Vote for elected positions and other leadership roles in the AAFP
- Receive instruction in parliamentary procedure and informed decision making
- Participate in discussion groups and develop and debate resolutions
- Learn about the AAFP's strategic priorities and how the Academy and other key organizations are addressing issues of importance to residents

Eligible candidates must:

- Be a resident member in good standing with the OAFP and the AAFP
- Be a resident in good standing at their residency program
- Have participated in at least one OAFP activity (event, program, committee, etc.)
- Disclose additional funding received to attend the conference (*Please note: additional funding received by the selected delegate/alternate will be deducted from the reimbursement amount available.*)

Eligible candidates must submit:

- A completed resident delegate application
- A current CV
- A statement of interest explaining your interest in family medicine and why you wish to represent Ohio residents at the congress (*no more than one typewritten page*)

Post-conference, the delegate and alternate delegate must submit:

- A written report of their experience (*typically 2-3 pages*)
- Receipts for travel reimbursement

The deadline to apply is **Monday, May 26, 2025**. The OAFP Foundation Executive Committee will select a delegate and alternate delegate; selected applicants will be notified the first week of June. The delegate and alternate delegate will have applicable travel expenses to participate in the congress and FUTURE reimbursed by the OAFP Foundation - this includes early bird conference registration, airfare, mileage, and hotel.
