

## How To Contact Your State Legislators

(State Representative/Senator)

To contact your State Legislators you first need to find out who they are (if you don't already know). To do that you will need to visit the Ohio Legislature website ([www.legislature.ohio.gov](http://www.legislature.ohio.gov)).

From the Ohio Legislature website, you will notice that you can use your address or Zip+4 to search for your legislators.

Follow the links that appear on the map images to the legislator's official websites where you'll find information on the legislator including their contact information, phone number, and a form email. That form is a bit limiting SO you can also email them more directly at their district email address.

Each House email address begins with the letters REP (short for Representative) followed by the number of the House district that member represents and then @ohiohouse.gov. For example, Rep92@ohiohouse.gov or Rep02@ohiohouse.gov.

For members of the Ohio Senate, their addresses begin with the senator's last name followed by @ohiosenate.gov. For example, Smith@ohiosenate.gov .

Note: There are currently two Senators with the last name Huffman, Senator Matt Huffman is MHuffman@ohiosenate.gov and Senator Stephen Huffman is SHuffman@ohiosenate.gov.

If in doubt, simply call your legislator's office and ask for their district email address.

If you already know who your legislators are, you can find contact information for the State House of Representatives [here](#) and for the State Senate [here](#).

It's best to keep your messages personal using your own words to share the story of your lived experience about any current issue. Your own words are ALWAYS better at getting the message across to legislators.
