Helps create and implement high value clinical education, quality initiatives, and programs that assist members in meeting their family medicine certification requirements.

Communications Resource Team

A virtual group of members that provides feedback on OAFP publications and communications vehicles to ensure effective communications that inform, inspire, and activate members.

Health Equity Workgroup

This group will assist family physicians in becoming champions of population health and influencers of health equity within their communities.

Family Medicine Leadership Initiative Workgroup

Helps create a family medicine leadership initiative, work plan, and measures for ongoing sustainability and success that reaches members at all levels of their careers through a multi-channel education and communication strategy.

Family Medicine Workshop Workgroup

Plans the annual Family Medicine Workshop.

Meaningful Engagement Experiences Workgroup & Family Medicine Celebration

Explores ways to provide members with meaningful engagement experiences with the Academy through in-person and virtual events and the Family Medicine Celebration.

Member Constituencies Workgroup

Selects the OAFP delegates to the National Conference of Constituency Leaders (NCCL) and mentors those delegates to run for NCCL positions (*must have served as an NCCL delegate in the past*).

Practice Resource Team

A virtual group of physician volunteers who responds to practice issues, questions, and concerns from members and OAFP staff.

Public Policy Workgroup

Coordinates the OAFP's legislative activity, monitors state legislation, and state board regulatory actions.

Workforce Development Workgroup

Supports Ohio's family medicine residency programs and departments of family medicine in their efforts to recruit, train, and retain individuals for the Ohio family medicine Workforce. In addition, works to increase the retention rate of graduating family medicine residents who stay in Ohio to practice by 10% before the end of 2026.
