Awards Workgroup

Oversees the OAFP awards selection process (Family Physician of the Year; Family Medicine Educator of the Year; Resident Leadership Award; Torchlight Leadership Award; Friend of Family Medicine) and inspires others by highlighting their accomplishments and passion.

CME Planning Committee

Oversees the various CME programs conducted by the OAFP to include KSAs, quality improvement programming, clinical CME, and procedural workshops.

Communications Resource Teams

A virtual group of members who provide feedback on individual OAFP publications and other communications vehicles.

Family Medicine Workshop Workgroup

Plans the annual Family Medicine Workshop.

Family Medicine Celebration CME Workgroup

Plans the Family Medicine Celebration CME programming.

Family Medicine Educators Workgroup

Focuses on their role in advocating for educational funding streams that support an adequate primary care workforce, the Foundation's pipeline programs, and making student and residents aware of the importance of Academy membership.

Joy of Medicine Workgroup

Identifies ways to bring fun back to meetings; provides resources on physician wellness, resiliency, and self-care; encourages mentorship; and serves as inspirational beacon for Ohio's family physicians.

Member Constituencies Workgroup

Selects the OAFP delegates to the National Conference of Constituency Leaders (NCCL) and mentors those delegates to run for NCCL positions.

Payer and Practice Resource Team

A virtual group of physician volunteers who responds to practice issues, questions, and concerns from members.

Population Health/Social Determinants of Health Workgroup

Explores ways for the Academy to provide members with resources, education, and other tools that promote health equity and confront social determinants of care.

Public Policy Committee

Coordinates the OAFP's legislative activity, monitors state legislation, and state board regulatory actions.

Value-Based Payment Resource Team

A virtual group of physician volunteers who responds to value-based payment issues and questions.
